

Harpster's work has been published in over one hundred books and his illustrations have appeared on products like T-shirts, stickers, and toys. He now travels the country visiting schools and sharing his love of drawing. His school presentations are designed to get young students excited about creating their own characters and books. Harpster started his own publishing company, called Harptoons, in 2010 and is influencing a new generation of cartoonists.



A gluten free option will be available for the students who normally require it and salad bar will be available like normal at its regular cost.



ARLINGTON KINDERGARTEN SCREENING

Friday, March 24, 2023 has been set to conduct screening for children eligible to start kindergarten in the fall of 2023. If you have a child who will be 5 years old on or before August 1, 2023, and live in Arlington District, he/she is eligible to attend kindergarten. <u>Please call Mrs. Northrup at the school</u> (419-365-5123 ext.244) anytime between now and Friday, <u>March 10, 2023</u>. This is the only day the clinic will be conducted.

The screening is not for acceptance to kindergarten, it is simply to offer parents feedback on a child's readiness. Please make sure, even if your child is unable to make the screening date that all documents are still turned in to the office BEFORE March 24th.

An appointment time for the clinic and further information will be communicated to parents prior to the screening.
